

**Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok
Concerning Photos on Educational Documents, 2005 (B.E. 2548)**

In accordance with the Dress Code of 2001, the University Senate passed the announcement of Photos on Educational Documents, to be applied commencing Semester 2/ 2004 as follows:

1. Photos for educational documents can be color or black and white photos, 3 × 4 cm, straight face, taken no longer than 6 months, without any accessories, hats or black glasses
2. Students have to wear a uniform as stated in Dress Codes of 2001 (B.E. 2544)
3. Dress code of photos for official documents issued by the University is as follows:

Vocational level students

Male

1. formal short hair; no beard or mustache
2. plain white shirt in accordance with the Dress Code. The left-chest pocket shows the symbol, a red thread-embroidered rotary cutter blade on the pocket edge
3. black or navy-blue tie with the university symbol on it

Female

1. formal hairstyle or long hair tied together
2. plain white shirt as stated in the Dress Code, with logo buttons, a logo pin attached on left chest

Undergraduate level students

Male

1. formal short hair; no beard or mustache
2. plain white shirt, open collar in accordance with the Dress Code
3. wearing black or navy blue tie showing the university logo, and a plain navy blue or black suit
4. a student who is a civil servant must wear an official white suit

Female

1. formal hairstyle or long hair tied together
2. plain white shirt following the Dress Code with logo buttons, a logo pin attached on left chest
3. formal dress for a student who is a civil servant (official white suit)

Graduate level students

Male

1. formal short hair; no beard or mustache
2. plain white shirt in accordance with the Dress Code
3. Black or navy blue tie with the university symbol and a navy blue or black suit with no pattern or design
4. a student who is a civil servant wearing a formal white suit

Females

1. formal hairstyle or long hair tied together
2. plain white shirt in accordance with the Dress Code with logo buttons and a logo pin on left chest
3. formal dress for a student who is a civil servant (official white suit)

4. Document photos of students who have graduated

Vocational level

Male students who have completed vocational study

1. formal short hair; no beard or mustache
2. plain white shirt in accordance with the Dress Code with a left-chest pocket with a red thread-embroidered cutter on the pocket edge
3. Black or navy-blue tie with the university symbol on it

Female students who have completed vocational study

1. formal hairstyle or long hair tied together
2. plain white shirt in accordance with the Dress Code with logo buttons and a logo pin on left chest

Undergraduate level

Male students who have completed a Bachelor degree

1. formal short hair; no beard or mustache
2. plain white civil servant suit in accordance with the Dress Code, and a gown of the degree level
3. official white suit for a student who is a civil servant, and a graduation gown

Female students who have completed a Bachelor degree

1. formal hairstyle or long hair tied together
2. plain white shirt in accordance with the Dress Code, with logo buttons, collar buttoned up, a logo pin attached on left chest, wearing gown of the degree level

3. official white suit for a student who is a civil servant, and a graduation gown

Graduate level

Male, as master's or doctoral degree holders

1. formal short hair; no beard or mustache
2. plain white civil servant suit in accordance with the Dress Code, wearing a graduation gown
3. official white suit for a student who is a civil servant, and a graduation gown

Female, master's or doctoral degree holders

1. formal hairstyle or long hair tied together
2. plain white shirt in accordance with the Dress Code with logo buttons and a logo pin, and a graduation gown
3. Official white suit for a student who is a civil servant, and a graduation gown

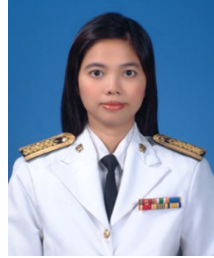
