

**The Regulation of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok
Concerning Fees and Educational Fees for the Undergraduate Programs
of the Faculty of Architecture and Design, 2010 (B.E. 2553)**

The Council of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok reached an agreement and approved the establishment of the faculty of Architect and Design. For the facilitation of administration, the regulation concerning the educational fees for students was drafted.

Based on the 2007 (B.E. 2550) Act of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok, Articles 22(2) and (14), Item 8.4 of the University Financial and Property regulation, 2008 (B.E. 2551), along with the resolution of the University Council on the meeting no. 6/2010, held on 3rd November, 2010, a regulatory framework of the University regulation concerning the educational fees for undergraduate programs was proposed:.

Item 1 The regulation is hereby entitled "the regulation of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok concerning the educational fees for undergraduate programs of the faculty of Architect and Design 2010."

Item 2 This regulation is to be active to new freshman students enrolling in Semester 1/ 2011 onward.

Item 3 In this regulation,

"University" refers to King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok.

"President" refers to the president of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok

Item 4 The institution is to charge general fees from students based on the designated rates from general fees in the University's Regulation concerning the Fees and Educational Fees for Vocational Certificate and Undergraduate Programs.

Item 5 The institution is to charge for educational fees from students in the undergraduate programs, the faculty of Architecture and Design as follows:

- (1) The educational fees for regular semester is 15,000 baht. In case a student has studied up to the number of semesters designated by the program but still has not been enrolled in all the courses as required by the program, the student is to be charged 5,000 baht per semester.
- (2) The educational fees for summer semester is 3,000 baht.
- (3) The fees for internship registration for summer semester is 3,000 baht.
- (4) The fees for maintaining student status in case the student has not completed the program and has not been enrolled in courses as required by the program is 500 baht per semester.
- (5) The fees for maintaining special project or thesis in a regular semester or summer semester is 3,000 baht per semester.

Item 6 Students are to pay for the fees and educational fees within the deadline designated by the institution. Reimbursement will not be done, except in the following cases:

- (1) Reimbursement of the property damage insurance according to Item 7(2) of the University Regulation Concerning Fees and Educational Fees for Vocational Certificate and Undergraduate Programs will be returned to the student after the termination of his/her student status and after deduction has been taken for any debts. In case a student does not file for reimbursement within 6 months from the termination of his/her student status, the property damage insurance is to become the institution's income.
- (2) Reimbursement in the case of the student whose payment for general fees and educational fees has been waived by the institution based on the notice of scholarship granted by the institution.

Item 7 The collection of income that is specified in this regulation, or in case the items above are not applicable, the case is to be presented to the Finance and Property Committee for approval prior to the drafting of a regulation by the institution.

Item 8 Students admitted before the academic year 2011 are to be charged for fees and educational fees according to the Regulation Concerning the Fees and Educational Fees for Vocational Certificate and Undergraduate programs.

Item 9 This regulation is overseen by the president of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok, who has the right to issue rules in compliance with this regulation. The president is entitled to the right to make the final decision pertaining to any problems in the decision-making or interpreting of this regulation.
