The Regulation of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok Concerning Education Fees and Application Fee for the Bachelor of Engineering Program in Electrical Engineering (Bilingual), 2011 (B.E. 2554)

For the efficient and effective administration of the Bachelor of Engineering Program in Electrical Engineering (Bilingual),, the regulation concerning the educational fees and application fee for the said program was devised.

Based on Article 22(2)and(14) of the University Act, 2007 (B.E.2550) along with the resolution of the University council following the meeting no. 1/2545 held on January 26, 2011, The University Regulation Concerning Education Fees and Application Fee for the Bachelor of Engineering Program in Electrical Engineering (Bilingual), 2011 was defined.

Item 1 this regulation is called "King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok, relating to Education Fees and Application Fee for the Bachelor of Engineering Program in Electrical Engineering (Bilingual), 2011

Item 2 This regulation is in effect from semester 1/2011 onward

Item 3 in this regulation

"University" means King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok.

"President of the university " means the president of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok

"Students" means persons attended the mentioned program.

"The Bachelor of Engineering Program in Electrical Engineering (Bilingual), " means a learning and an instruction program conducted in Thai and English languages following the respective curriculum.

Item 4 The university is to charge the education fees of 60,000 Baht per semester for the first eight semesters. A charge of 10,000 Baht per semester is imposed from the 9th semester onward until graduation or termination of student status.

Item 5 The charge of application fee and other fees will comply to the University regulation on fees and education fees and for the vocational certificate and undergraduate programs.

Item 6 To effectively facilitate the administration of the abovementioned program, the president is entitled to issue the University announcements on amendments of education fees with consent of the Planning and Policy committee. The notification the University council is required prior the official enforcement.

Item 7 The education fees pursuant to this regulation are deemed the University income. The University reserve to right to allocate the portions specially for educational advantages, academic purposes and other operations that are consistent with intuitional objectives.

Item 8 The disbursement process for administering the program is expected to comply with established policies and procedures in the University announcement.

Item 9 The regulation is overseen by the president, who is entitled to issue the University announcements for regulatory implementation in line with the regulation. In case of any problems in interpretation of the provision enacted, the president's judgement is deemed absolute.
