The Regulation of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok Concerning the Tuition and Application Fees for the Doctoral Program in Industrial Engineering, Faculty of Engineering According to the Cooperation Project on Academic Staff Development at King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok, 2011 (B.E. 2554)

It is deemed appropriate to establish regulations of the tuition and application fees, and qualifications of candidates for the Doctoral Degree Program in Industrial Engineering, Faculty of Engineering according to the Cooperation Project on Academic Staff Development at King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok,

By virtue of Article 22 (2) and (14) of the King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok Act 2007, and item 8.4 of the King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok Policy of Finance, Budget, and Property 2008, together with the resolution of the University Council in the meeting no. 4/2011 on 13 July 2011, the approved regulation was defined as follows:

Item 1 The regulation shall henceforth be known as "Regulations of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok Concerning the Payment of Education Support and Application Fees for the Doctoral Degree Program in Industrial Engineering, Faculty of Engineering according to the Cooperation Project on Academic Staff Development at King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok, 2011".

Item 2 The regulation shall apply to all students who enrolled from semester 1/2011 and afterwards.

Item 3 In these regulations:

"University" means King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok.

"President" means the President of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok.

"Cooperation Project" means the Cooperation Project on Academic Staff Development at King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok for the stated degree program Type 2.1.

"Faculty" means the Faculty of Engineering, King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok.

"Department" means units in the faculty, responsible for administration and supervision of instructional programs.

"Students" means individuals enrolled in the Doctor of Philosophy degree program in Industrial Engineering, Faculty of Engineering according to the Cooperation Project on Academic Staff Development at King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok.

Item 4 Qualifications of Candidates:

- (1) Candidates must be academic staff of the University
- (2) Candidates must have at least 2 years' experience in teaching, or in academic work related to vocational or technical education.
- (3) Candidates are required to hold a Master's degree in Engineering (Plan A) that requires the completion of a thesis) with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25. Candidates completing the Plan B (non-thesis) Master's Program must have an article published in a national academic journal recognized by the Department.

Consideration on the candidate's eligibility to study in the program and any plans must be approved by the Committee of the Department of Industrial Engineering or its equivalent from Higher Education Institutions accredited by the Committee of Higher Education.

(4) Candidates have never been terminated from student status due to failure to pass a qualifying examination of the program, for which the candidates are applying.

Item 5 Students in the Doctoral Degree Program in Industrial Engineering, Faculty of Engineering, must pay the fees in accordance with the rates set by the University Regulations for the payment of tuition, registration and education services fees of the Graduate programs.

Item 6 Students in the Doctoral Degree Program in Industrial Engineering, Faculty of Engineering, must pay tuition fees according to these rates: fee charge is 75,000 baht a semester for the first 6 semesters, and 10,000 baht a semester from semester 7 until graduation or the end of study period.

Item 7 Fees, tuition fees and other expenses must be paid within the scheduled period. All payments are non-refundable, except the following:

- (1) Fee for property damage insurance according to Item 5(1) of the University Regulations on the payment of tuition, registration and education services fees of the Graduate programs will be returned to the students when their student status is terminated, after the deduction of repayment for responsible debts or burdens. Should the students not appeal to get their money back within 6 months from the date that their student status is terminated, the money for property damage insurance will become the University income.
- (2) Students who received an exemption of fees, tuition fee according to announcements of the University scholarships, and exemption of other fees that are charged commensurate with the University Regulations on general fees as well as tuition and registration fees of the Graduate programs.

Item 8 Criteria on income withdrawal and payment for the Doctor of Philosophy Program in Industrial Engineering, Faculty of Engineering, are consistent with the University Announcements.

Item 9 The President oversees this regulation and is authorized to formulate any announcements in compliance with the regulation. In cases where of any doubts or problems in interpretation, the judgment of the President of King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok is considered final.
