

Announcement of the Commencement Ceremony Organizing Committee of King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang, King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok and King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi for the Academic Year 2022

regarding the Guidelines and Measures to Protect the Spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) in the Commencement Ceremony for the Academic Year 2022

Whereas King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang, King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok and King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi will hold the Commencement Ceremony for the graduates of the academic year 2022 during November 14-16, 2023,

Therefore, in order to ensure that this will be proceeded properly according to the guidelines and measures to protect the spread of Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19), we would like to make announcement as follows:

- 1. The graduates must perform self-screening test for genetic material of the virus disease with COVID-19 Antigen Test Kit no more than 24 hours before the date of the Commencement Ceremony at their own cost. The graduates, then, must report the screening test result by themselves via the University's system at <a href="https://commencement.kmitl.ac.th">https://commencement.kmitl.ac.th</a> We reserve the right NOT to permit those graduates with positive result of the Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) infection to attend the Commencement Ceremony.
- 2. All graduates must wear the medical face mask, measure body temperature at the screening check point, keep physical distance and always clean hands with alcohol gel. If it happens that the body temperature is higher than 37.5 degree Celsius, such graduate is to sit and rest for 10 minutes before proceeding to double screening check. If the temperature is not decreased, such graduate shall proceed to the Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) infection risk assessment and receive the screening test for genetic material of the virus disease with Professional ATK (Antigen Test Kit) only at the screening check point provided by the Committee. If the test result confirms that such graduate is not infected with the Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19), he/she will be able to attend the ceremony.

In case the test result from the Professional ATK (Antigen Test Kit) at the screening check point provided by the Committee shows positive result and the Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) is detected, the Committee reserve the right NOT to permit such graduate with the positive Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) infection result to attend the Commencement Ceremony.

- 3. In case any graduates who are high-risk contact, they must inform the staff on the date of reporting to attend the Commencement Ceremony and such graduates are requested to properly wear the face mask at all times.
- 4. If any graduates are having any unusual symptoms like fever, cough, sore throat, running nose, headache, muscle ache, panting & fatigue, decreased sense of smell, they must report to the Ceremony staff or the Committee immediately.
- 5. During 14 days after the Commencement Ceremony is completed, the graduates are to strictly perform according to the measures of the Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) protection of the Ministry of Public Health which are D-M-H-T-T-A (keeping physical distance wearing mass always washing hands measuring body temperature if finding out that being in risk, perform screening test with ATK kit). If it is found out that any one is infected with Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19), such person must report back to his/her supervisory department immediately in order to proceed according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control of the Ministry of Public Health.

In case of any suspicion on the symptoms or the risk of Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19), it is the power of the Commencement Ceremony Organizing Committee for the academic year 2022 to make decision which shall be deemed final.
